Explanation Provided that the Governor may, as soon as possible after the presentation to him/ her of the bill for assent, return the bill if it is not a Money bill together with a message requesting that the house or Houses will reconsider the bill or any speci ed provisions thereof and, in particular, will consider the desirability of introducing any such amendments as he/ she may recommend in his/ her message and, when a bill is so returned, the house or houses shall reconsider the bill accordingly, and if the bill is passed again by the house or houses with or without amendment and presented to the Governor for assent, the Governor shall not withhold assent there from.
