Answer B

Explanation: there is NO explicit provision of the constitution which the Supreme Court adheres to Public Interest Litigation

Question 2

Answer B

Explanation: They are drawn from both the judicial and administrative streams.

Question 3

Answer A

Explanation: The District Judge is appointed by the Governor in Consultation with the Chief Justice of the High Court.

Question 4

Answer A

Explanation: The judge of a High Court is not allowed to practice law before the authority of the same court except the Supreme Court & any other High Court.

Question 5

Answer A

Explanation: There is no minimum age for a person to be appointed as a High Court judge but should have relevant experience. His/ her salary is charged upon the consolidated fund of the state(s).

Question 6

Answer B

Explanation: The salaries and allowances of the Judges of the HC are charged to the Consolidated Fund of the state but their pensions are payable as Charged Expenditure /Art 112(3).

Question 7

Answer D

Explanation: PN Bhagwati was CJI during July 1985–Dec 1986. During his tenure as CJI, PIL was introduced to the Indian judicial system.
